While at Camp

PRAYER Church camp is full of fun and fellowship, but most importantly, a time for children to grow in their relationship with God. Please pray for your camper and their leaders.

CLOSED CAMP No visitors are allowed at camp. No unregistered minors are allowed at camp, even those of church staff members.

DINING Three meals are provided each day. A risk of accidental exposure to **food allergens** may be present. Camp staff, parents and campers should work together to minimize the risk.

DISCIPLINE Camp dean is responsible for overall camp discipline. Church shepherds are responsible for all supervision, enforcement of all rules and conduct of their campers. In extreme situations, parents may be required to pick up camper.

HEALTH CENTER All medications

must be turned in to the Camp Health Center to be kept & dispensed there.

In case of serious injury or illness, the health supervisor will call the parent to determine if a camper should be taken to a doctor or hospital. If the camper is taken, a copy of their registration form will be sent with a church leader and camper. Parents will be asked to meet the camper at the hospital or doctor's office if necessary.

HOW TO REACH YOUR CAMPER

Campers will not be allowed to keep phones or call home during the week. Parents may text church leaders anytime to check in. More contact information will be provided at Monday drop-off.
